CTE Purpose and Program Expectations

Purpose:

- CTE courses teach the knowledge and skills required by certain industries focusing on applied learned methodology and work-based learning to prepare students for careers in high-wage, high skill, and/or in-demand careers.
- CTE courses include leadership and employablility skills as an integral part of the curriculum.

Expectations:

Students can earn the opportunity to earn up to 12 college credits offered via CSN at the end of successfully completing a course program with a B average (3.0) and passing the end of course exams. Course of Study programs are two-three years long.


