

Implementation Plan - EdReady™ Year 2 Maximizing the EdReady™ Program

EdReady™ is a personalized college math preparation program designed to help learners test their college math readiness, view study options, and follow a personalized student path to fill in the knowledge gaps.

The online EdReady™ program will launch on **Tuesday, November 1, 2016**. It will provide students with access to measure and improve their mathematics skills using three options:

- ACT Preparation
- College Readiness Math
- Accuplacer

Please encourage all 11th graders to log-in and take the diagnostic in preparation for the statewide ACT exam on in February.

Each high school will use the Canvas Learning Management System to access EdReady™. All 11th and 12th grade students will be enrolled in ACT Preparation 101 in Infinite Campus.

How can EdReady™ serve my students and staff?

Students will access the EdReady™ content through Canvas. Computers, tablets, and laptops will need to be available for students during the school day for the initial log-in. You may select one or all of the following ways to use EdReady™:

- **Blended Learning*:**
Students enrolled are enrolled in a designated math course at the school site, attend in the classroom or computer lab and access online content with Canvas LMS and teacher support.
**Using the following models: Rotation, Station, Lab, Flipped, Individual, Flex, and A La Carte*
- **Classroom Supplement:**
Math teachers incorporate supplemental materials and lessons from EdReady™ in the classroom.
- **Fully Online Course:**
EdReady™ is offered as an additional course after the normal school day, held entirely online. Students initially log-in at school, then continue the program using their own resources before and after school and at home.

How do I know if my students are using EdReady™?

Administrators, teachers designated as instructors, and CTE OSIs can access data from the Canvas Learning Management System.

What are the roles of the site-based staff?

- **Curriculum Administrator**
 - Teacher of Record for the Infinite Campus *course ACT101AA0 ACT Preparation*
 - Add course to the school's master schedule as an early or late bird class hour
- **Mathematics Department Chair**
 - Access to the Canvas Course
 - Determine additional teachers to be added as instructors in the Canvas Learning Management System
- **Counselor**
 - Add *ACT101AA0 ACT Preparation* to every newly registered 11th or 12th grade student in Infinite Campus after Tuesday, November 1, 2016
- **The CTE College and Career Center OSII or designee**
 - Provide support by assisting teachers and ensuring students receive instructions on how to login to the Canvas LMS and navigate the EdReady™ program
