Make sure that you bring your laptop and that you and your guardian create an [FSA ID](#) 48 hours prior to attending.

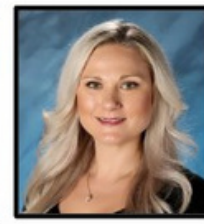
