3.1 Strategic Budget Update for 2020-2021

Mr. Roberts updated the team on potential budget cuts for the upcoming school year. He explained that the cuts could amount to anywhere from \$100 per student to \$300 per student. He explained that the school would likely be able to weather the cuts regardless of the amount due to the fact that the school has carefully managed its budget and also due to the fact that some positions which were budgeted for in February would no longer be needed since students would not be on campus for the foreseeable future. Mr. Roberts also gave the team more details about the school's desire to build a robotics lab on the campus to support the school's very successful and expanding Robotics program. This project would also allow the school to expand its Art program by opening up another classroom space suitable for an Art room.

3.2 School Performance Plan 2020-2021

Mr. Roberts explained that the school would be assembling a committee to look at the school's data relative to the Nevada State Performance Framework which would then make recommendations to the SOT in terms of a final plan. The SOT would then make suggestions regarding the plan and vote to approve it at the meeting in October.

3.3 Personnel update

Mr. Roberts informed the SOT about recent personnel changes due to some late resignations and retirements and informed that SOT that the school would be working quickly to fill those positions. He also explained that a couple of support staff positions would remain unfilled until the actual size of the projected budget cuts is known.
