- 3.1 Presentation of Preliminary School Budget Mr. Roberts presented the school budget to the members of the SOT. He explained that the school would be looking to add an additional teaching position in the area of Foreign Language as well as one additional Support Staff position. Mr. Roberts explained that the lack of students on campus has forced the school to think differently about its staffing plan, especially with regard to support staff as there simply isn't the need for as many Support Staff personnel right now as there normally would be. He also explained that the school was planning on using some of its funds to build a Robotics lab on campus to further support the growing program. It would also create another open classroom that could be used for an additional Art or CTE program the following school year. The SOT team approved the budget as presented.
