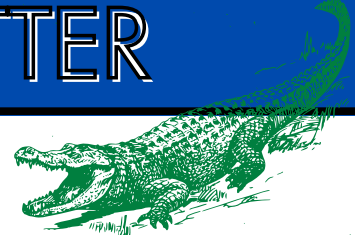

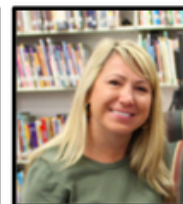

HOPE Squad is a group of students nominated by themselves or peers who work closely with the SEL school counselor with the following goals:

- Prevent suicide and reduce stigma through awareness & education
- Serve as a resource to those touched by suicide.
- Recognizing warning signs & provide support.
- Encourage peers to speak with a trusted adult.

Our mission is to reduce youth suicide through education, training, and peer intervention.

We are looking for new members for the 2024-25 school year! Meetings are Thursdays after school beginning 8/29/24. We will be selecting our new officers and planning our events, such as our First Friday booth and filling the front gate with ribbons to show support for suicide prevention.

Suicide Prevention Month is in September & National Suicide Prevention week is September 8-14. During this week, we will have activities at lunch where students can participate and learn more about HOPE Squad.

Statistics show that youth who are contemplating ideation will frequently give warning signs. Seven out of ten students will tell a friend, but the friends will not tell an adult. Hope Squad is geared to teach participants how to recognize the signs of ideation and how to report them to a trusted adult. HOPE Squad members will help promote awareness at our annual HOPE week where fellow peers are given information about suicide prevention.
