

Green Valley High School Cell Phone Policy

Students are prohibited from using personal communication devices (e.g., cell phones, tablets) during the instructional day on all district campuses. Devices may be used during lunch and on district buses, as long as use is not disruptive. During class time, devices must be out of sight and unused. Policy violations will result in disciplinary action per the Clark County School District's Behavior Guidelines for Secondary Students

Cell Phone Procedures:

Upon entering class, students must store their cell phones in one of the following designated locations:

- A clothing pocket
- A purse or backpack
- School-provided storage at their desk

Failure to follow this procedure will result in progressive disciplinary action as outlined below.

Violation #	Student Consequence
1 & 2	 Classroom Verbal Warning Phone confiscated by classroom teacher until end of class Minor Behavior Incident Submitted for Disregard of Rules/ Regulations entered in Infinite Campus
3 & 4	 Classroom Verbal Warning Phone confiscated and sent to the Student Success Office. <u>Student</u> pick up at the end of the day. Parent Contacted Minor Behavior Incident Submitted for Disregard of Rules/ Regulations entered in Infinite Campus
5 +	 Referral to Student Success Office for INSUBORDINATION Phone confiscated and sent to the Student Success Office. <u>Parent</u> pick up required at the end of the day. Student Placed in In-House Suspension Continual violations of Cell Phone Policy WILL result in progressive discipline

Please note: Students are required to leave their cell phones in the classroom when taking restroom breaks. Any phone found in the hallway during this time will be confiscated and may be retrieved at the end of the school day

Failure to comply with the Cell Phone Policy, a referral for INSUBORDINATION will be entered and progressive discipline will be issued.
