Students are expected to maintain a standard of dress, personal appearance, and behavior that supports a positive and effective educational environment. Any style of dress or conduct that disrupts learning, undermines classroom discipline, or distracts from instruction is not permitted.

Green Valley High School adheres to the Clark County School District (CCSD) Regulation 5131 regarding student dress. The school administration reserves the authority to determine whether specific styles, fashions, trends, or appearances interfere with the educational process or present potential safety concerns.

- **Deliveries:** Deliveries of replacement clothing will not be accepted during the school day.
- **Change of Clothes:** If a change of clothing is required, Green Valley High School will provide temporary clothing. Temporary clothing must be washed and returned in good condition before personal items are released back to the student.
